This diversity seminar is suitable for any corporate diversity training program, and relates diversity issues to participation in track & field.

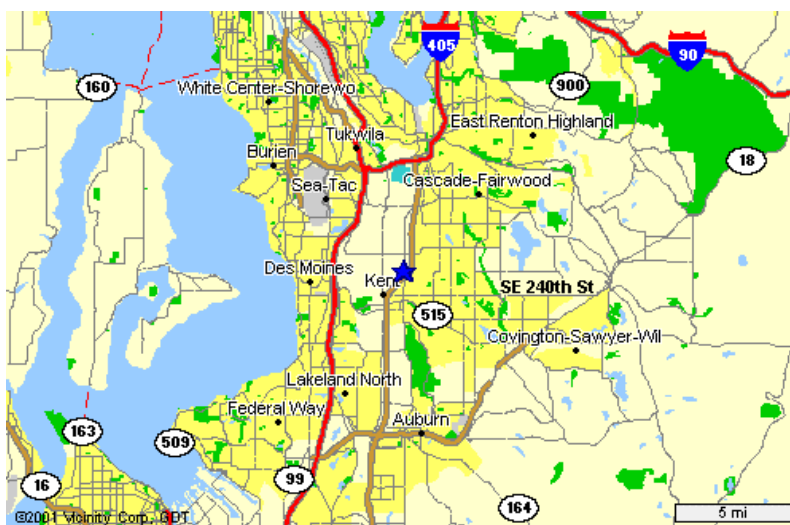
