30th Annual USCAA National Corporate Cup Relays

The U.S. Corporate Athletics Association (USCAA) invites you to participate and be a part of this year's National Corporate Cup Relays. Scheduled to be held in San Diego, California on July 21-22, 2007, this year's event will be the 30th Annual Relays and promises to be one of the best ever. We welcome you to come out and compete, set up a product table at the meet, donate products, advertise, or help sponsor the event.

The USCAA National Corporate Cup Relays is comprised of events that are team or relay-oriented and structured to be equally competitive for men and women of all ages. Current employees, as well as alumni, retirees, and contractors may also be eligible to participate. The competition allows both the weekend warrior and the former college track star to participate in the same event and to contribute equally to a team's success. Individual distances in the relays range from 100 meters up to 2 miles on the track, coupled with team shot put, discus, high jump, and long jump field events. In addition to the track and field events, there are also 5K and 10K road races.

Two non-scoring events also take place: a 4-person relay consisting of two Special Olympic athletes and two corporate athletes, and a Korporate Kids Run for children ages 1 to 16 (in 5-year increments) competing in events up to 100 meters. The USCAA National Corporate Cup Relays are fun and competitive, engender long-lasting camaraderie, build a strong networking base, and benefit worthy charities - including the American Cancer Society®. The full weekend of events closes with an energetic post-meet party for all participants, families and friends.

The USCAA is a nationwide non-profit and philanthropic organization that promotes health and fitness among corporate employees. It is made up of corporate athletes - both slow and fast - and is organized by a volunteer board of directors from across corporate America. Together they organize a variety of annual corporate races, including the USCAA Marathon Championship, USCAA 10-Mile Championship, and USCAA National Corporate Cup Relays - the largest of these competitions.

The USCAA is happy to help you form a competitive and fun team from your local, regional, national or even international employee base - there are no restrictions, to compete in one of four divisions based on company employee size. Teams may be any size (10-30 is common at first) and several smaller companies may even join together to form one team.
